Chief Master Sergeant Paul M. Walker Jr. is the Command Chief, 557th Weather Wing, Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska. He advises the Commander on all issues regarding health, welfare, morale and effective utilization of more than 1,450 personnel serving at 18 locations around the world. The 557th Weather Wing provides centralized weather products and services; including climatological and space weather support to Air Force, Army, Joint Force and other Department of Defense activities enabling air and space superiority, intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance, rapid global mobility, global strike and command and control in support of all geographic and functional combatant commands.

Chief Walker entered the Air Force in February 1993. A career weather Airman supporting Air Force and Army operations, including deployed tours in Macedonia, Iraq and Afghanistan, he has served in leadership positions at the flight, squadron, group and major command levels.

Prior to assuming his current position, he served as the Enlisted Weather Operations Functional Manager, Air Force Global Strike Command Barksdale Air Force Base, Louisiana.
